As homeowners face up to the realities of ever increasing fuel bills triple glazing will become progressively more important tool for fabricators and installers.

Adding triple glazed windows to a property will improve its security, energy efficiency and sound insulation. The Swish Twentyfour-seven system incorporates a 44mm sealed unit and the custom designed bead co-ordinates with the contours of the sculptured profile.

A triple glazed standard specification window will allow you to achieve a U-value of 0.8, well ahead of the equivalent typical double glazed option of 1.5 for an A rated window. Three panes of glass also provide additional security by affording extra protection from break in via broken glass.
